SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 30, 2006  
7:00 P.M.

Mayor Copeland opened the meeting. Councilmember Stewart lead the prayer and Councilmember Brown lead the pledge.

Mayor Copeland asked that agenda item number five would be substituted for Mary Gilbert, of the American Cancer Society. Councilmember Brown made the motion to approve and Councilmember Notti seconded. The vote was six in favor.

Mayor Copeland opened the floor for public comments.

Mayor Copeland opened the floor for Council comments.

Mayor Copeland opened the floor for Final Plat approvals. Mr. Rodney Heard was not present at that time.

Councilmember Brown asked for the Council to move forward to items that needed to be postponed.

Councilmember Notti made a motion to postpone the Jenny Walker for JHW Properties item until June 19, 2006. Councilmember Smith seconded. The vote was six in favor.

Councilmember Stewart made a motion to postpone the Lakemont Subdivision item until June 5, 2006. Councilmember Smith seconded. The vote was six in favor.

Mr. Heard asked that the Iris Lake and Green Valley items be postponed to be discussed on June 1, 2006, and voted on June 5, 2006.

Councilmember Brown made a motion to postpone the discussion and vote for the Iris Lake item. Councilmember Smith seconded. The vote was six in favor.

Councilmember Brown made a motion to postpone the discussion and vote for the green Valley item. Councilmember Notti seconded. The vote was six in favor.

Mr. Heard gave a review of the Rainer Park zoning modifications. He also gave a report relative to the agreement reached with Mr. Buddy Phillips. Mr. Heard reviewed a map showing the construction entrance for the area. Councilmember Notti asked for clarification based on past modifications; Mr. Heard provided a review. Mr. Lee reported that approval of the final plat is being recommended and requested. Mayor Copeland opened the floor for comment by Mr. Buddy Phillips, who spoke briefly. Mayor Copeland opened the floor to Council comments and

questions. Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve the final plat. Councilmember Notti seconded. The vote was six in favor.

Mayor Copeland opened the floor to Mrs. Mary Gilbert, who spoke about the American Cancer Society.

Mayor Copeland opened the floor to comments and announcements from the Council.

Councilmember Brown reported that Mr. Heard's packets and the agendas can be e-mailed. There was a discussion relative to the topic.
