The Special Called City of McDonough Council Meeting was held on Tuesday, July 26, 2011, at 7:30 PM with the following members present:

Mayor Copeland called the meeting to order at 7:38 P.M.

Councilmember Notti led the Pledge to the Flag and Mayor Pro Tem Vincent gave the invocation.

City Administrator, Mr. Billy Beckett discussed his recommendation for the 2011 tax millage rate for the City of McDonough. He requested that the millage rate be increased from 3.45 to 4.393 for the budget year beginning July 1, 2011 ending June 30, 2012.

Mayor Copeland asked for a motion regarding the millage rate. Mayor Pro Tem Vincent motioned to approve the new millage rate which will be set at 4.393, and for the record to reflect that there were no substantial objections from the community. Councilmember Brown seconded the motion. The vote was five in favor.

City Administrator, Mr. Beckett advised Council that the City had received approval from the Department of Justice regarding the redistricting plan.

City Clerk, Ms. Janis Price, requested that Mayor and Council please bring the Community Visioning report, which had been placed at their council seat, back to the Workshop on Thursday night since the report would be discussed.

Councilmember Notti asked Council and guests to join her in remembering Mr. Zack Hinton and his contributions to the community.

Having no further business Mayor Copeland asked for a motion to adjourn. Councilmember Smith motioned and Councilmember Amis seconded. The vote was five in favor. The meeting adjourned at 7:53 PM.
